The following is a list of the rules and regulations of the Salesian College Preparatory Senior/Junior Prom

The Senior/Junior Prom is from 7:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. **The doors close at 8:30 p.m. and reopen at 10:30 p.m. NO ONE will be allowed to enter or exit the dance after 8:30 p.m.**

- Tickets must be purchased by Thursday, April 14th. Tickets will not be sold at the door.
- Guest pass forms must be submitted by Tuesday, April 26th.
- Each Salesian student may bring only one guest. The guest must be in high school. Please see the Principal for any exceptions to this rule.
- Student guests must bring a current photo ID to the dance. Guests will not be permitted into the prom without their ID or without their host present.
- The Senior/Junior Prom is a Formal Dance. Students not in compliance with the dress code will not be admitted to the dance.
 - **Acceptable Formal Dress:**
 - Tuxedos, suits (with a jacket, shirt, and tie), and dress shoes. A shirt and tie must be worn all evening.
 - Evening dress or gown (strapless or spaghetti straps are OK) and dress shoes.
 - If a dress has a side, front, or back slit, the slit CANNOT be more than 3 inches above the knee.
 - If a short formal dress is worn, the hemline CANNOT be higher than 3 inches above the knee.
 - Black athletic shoes are okay
 - **Unacceptable Formal Dress:**
 - Baseball caps of any kind
 - Non-black athletic shoes
 - Dresses with plunging necklines or backs
 - Dress slits that are more than 3 inches above the knee.
 - Dress hemlines that are higher than 3 inches above the knee.
 - Dresses with bare midriffs or side/back cut outs

***Students NOT IN COMPLIANCE with the Formal Dress Code policy listed above will be sent home after their parents have been notified.**

Students and their guests are expected to follow Salesian Dance Policy Guidelines and behave in a manner fitting a Catholic School and a Formal Dance.

- Students must behave respectfully towards all staff and other students.
- Students and guests may have their bags, purses and persons searched prior to entry into the dance.
- There is to be no inappropriate dancing or any sexually suggestive behavior.
- No violent mosh pitting.
- During the dance, the student host is 100% responsible for their guest's behavior and for making sure the guest is aware of all rules.
- **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS ARE ALLOWED AT THE SENIOR/JUNIOR PROM.** However, if a student and/or their guest demonstrate the effects of alcohol or drugs at the dance, their parents will be notified and asked to pick them up.

Breaking any of these guidelines is cause for immediate removal from the dance for both the host and guest. Both the parents and high school administrators of the host and guest will be notified, and participation in future activities will be jeopardized. No future guest passes will be issued to the host.
