#### Essential Duties and Responsibilities of a Cross Country Coach

- Understand and implement all NFHS cross country rules and regulations
- Understand and implement all TCAL and NCS/CIF by-laws
- Plan daily practices that bring out the best in your runners and allow you to identify the talent levels of each team member
- Optimize individual performance through individual assessments
- Manage meets effectively, including timing, scoring, and reporting results
- Communicate and work well with parents, young people, teachers, administrators, and staff
- Develop and implement a budget with the Salesian CFO and athletic director for travel, equipment, uniforms, and other expenses related to the cross country team
- Complete all onboarding certification required by Salesian
- Teach cross country skills, strategies, and tactics to high school runners regardless of experience level
- Work with the Salesian athletic director to develop and plan a meet schedule for the season that maximizes the potential for runners
- Attend all school, league, and section meetings when and where applicable
- Report all injuries to the Salesian athletic trainer and work with her to return student-athletes to play in a safe manner
- Conduct a pre-season parent meeting to discuss team and individual expectations
- Contribute to team social media page providing content where applicable
- Develop and implement an off-season program for students interested in improving their running skills; provide open run opportunities during the off-season
- Oversee the hiring of assistant coaches in conjunction with the Salesian athletic director and human resources person
- Participate in special activities to include school open houses, banquets, award nights, and pep assemblies where applicable
- Model sports-like behavior and maintains appropriate conduct towards students, officials, and spectators
